A new and exciting feature for the 2023 Parents Program was a short play the kids created. The play was based on the dramatic battle of 1000AD which took the life of King Olav I. This was one of the campers heritage units. The campers learned about the history of the Viking Era and the reasons why vikings raided and traded. The campers created their own props and costumes. They worked hard rehearsing the play, to make this story come to life.

The music used in the program is from a recording provided by their instructors, Karen and Steve Nichols. The music was performed by a Norwegian 4 part men's chorus and composed by F.A. Reissiger, a German-Norwegian composer. Bj. Bjørnson, the first Norwegian to win the Nobel Prize in Literature wrote the lyrics. The song was originally performed in 1865.


