

Penny's Rosemaling Seminar  
at Camp Norge  
27-28 April 2024

Classes are open to adults 18 years and older. Classes are limited to twenty-one (21) students each. Once class limits are met, a short waitlist will be established. **Registration closes on April 7<sup>th</sup>.**

**SEMINAR COST:** The cost of the seminar is \$150, which includes instruction, wood piece, paints and mediums for use during class, design packet, and five (5) meals. If you have received confirmation, but find that you are unable to attend, please let me know as soon as possible so I can notify someone on the wait list. **Full refunds will be made for cancellations received before April 10<sup>th</sup> -- no refunds will be made after that date.**

**TEACHERS:** Our teachers are Onya Tolmasoff and Sue Regadanz, filling in for Karen Nelson, VGM.

**PROJECT:** We will be painting a charming stool, made of poplar and produced by Larry Pickett (mpick1114@aol.com). The stool measures 14"x 8 3/4" and is 8" tall. The design area on the top of the stool will be taught during class. The other areas will be addressed as time allows.

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**MEALS:** Saturday breakfast, lunch, and dinner; Sunday breakfast and lunch; coffee/tea during breaks. Melanie and Patrick Souza will again do our cooking. Family members who are not painting can pay \$60 for meals. Thank you, Melanie and Patrick, for your continued support of Penny's Rosemaling Seminars!

**COOKIES:** During the coffee/tea breaks, cookies and other refreshments are provided by the participants in the specified class (to be noted on your confirmation). Each participant is asked to bring one dozen cookies or the equivalent of other refreshments to share.

**ROOMS:** Lodging is not included in the registration fee. Please make your bed reservation at the time you register (see Registration Form). You will pay for your lodging when you arrive at Camp. Current Sons of Norway members pay \$27.00 per night; non-members pay \$37.80 per night (both include an 8% Placer County Occupancy Tax). We are obligated for both Friday and Saturday nights, so each person will pay a total of \$54.00 (SoN member) or \$75.60 (non-member). For people wanting to room together, please include that information on the registration form. Since there are a limited number of beds available, RVs and tents are encouraged. For RVs, members pay \$30 per night, non-members pay \$40 per night (limited to four people per RV). RV spots have electrical and water, but no sewer hookups. For tents, members pay \$20 per night, non-members pay \$25 per night (limited to four people per tent). Again, the obligation is for two nights (\$60 or \$80 per RV; \$40 or \$50 per tent). There is no occupancy tax on RVs or tents. Pets are \$2 per night. Pets are allowed only in specified areas and advance notice must accompany your registration form. Heaters are available to rent for \$5 per night.
